TEMPORARY CHANGE TO TRUCK ACCESS FROM 9 JANUARY 2012

Urgent repairs are required to the pavement of the truck turnaround area at the Lyttelton Container Terminal. We will be undertaking this work over two weeks between 9 January and 23 January (weather dependent).

Container trucks accessing the LCT truck queuing lanes, as well as log trucks and other vehicles accessing the log yard on Gladstone Quay, will need to follow the access route indicated in the drawing on the following page.

As on previous occasions, trucks will need to turn left after passing through the main security gate and turn right through the temporary access that will cross the footpath just northwest of the LCT building (in the case of container trucks, if the queuing lanes beside the LCT building are full they will need to join the truck queue along the roadway.)

A temporary change in direction of the container truck queuing lanes is also indicated on the map.

Entry to the inner harbour will be via the main security gate adjacent to the C3 log office or via the inner harbour security gate. The road beside No.1 Breastworks will be closed and the road running parallel along the log storage area will be down to one lane, with traffic travelling east to give way to oncoming vehicles.
