


Onshore migrant workforce

What's new for temporary workers?

The Government has introduced a new temporary work visa called the **Accredited Employer Work Visa** (AEWV).

Six temporary work visas



One visa:
Accredited Employer Work Visa

Migrant-led



Employer-led, 3-check system

Some employers are accredited to hire on temporary work visas



All employers must be accredited to hire on AEWVs

Old employer accreditation and approval in principle policies



New employer accreditation (different criteria and requirements)

Road ahead for freight transport sector

Like all sectors in NZ, the road freight transport sector is encouraged to attract, train, upskill and hire New Zealand workers.

AEWV offers a path for recruiting drivers at or above the median wage (NZD \$27.76 p/h)

Median wage

1047 Truck Drivers on Essential Skills

Nearly all paid above median wage



Green List – work to residence

Automotive electrician

A certificate at NZQF Level 4, or a higher qualification, which includes the credit and knowledge requirements of one of the strands of the New Zealand Certificate in Automotive Electrical Engineering

Diesel motor mechanic

A certificate at NZQF Level 4, or a higher qualification, which includes the credit and knowledge requirements of the New Zealand Certificate in Heavy Automotive Engineering.
