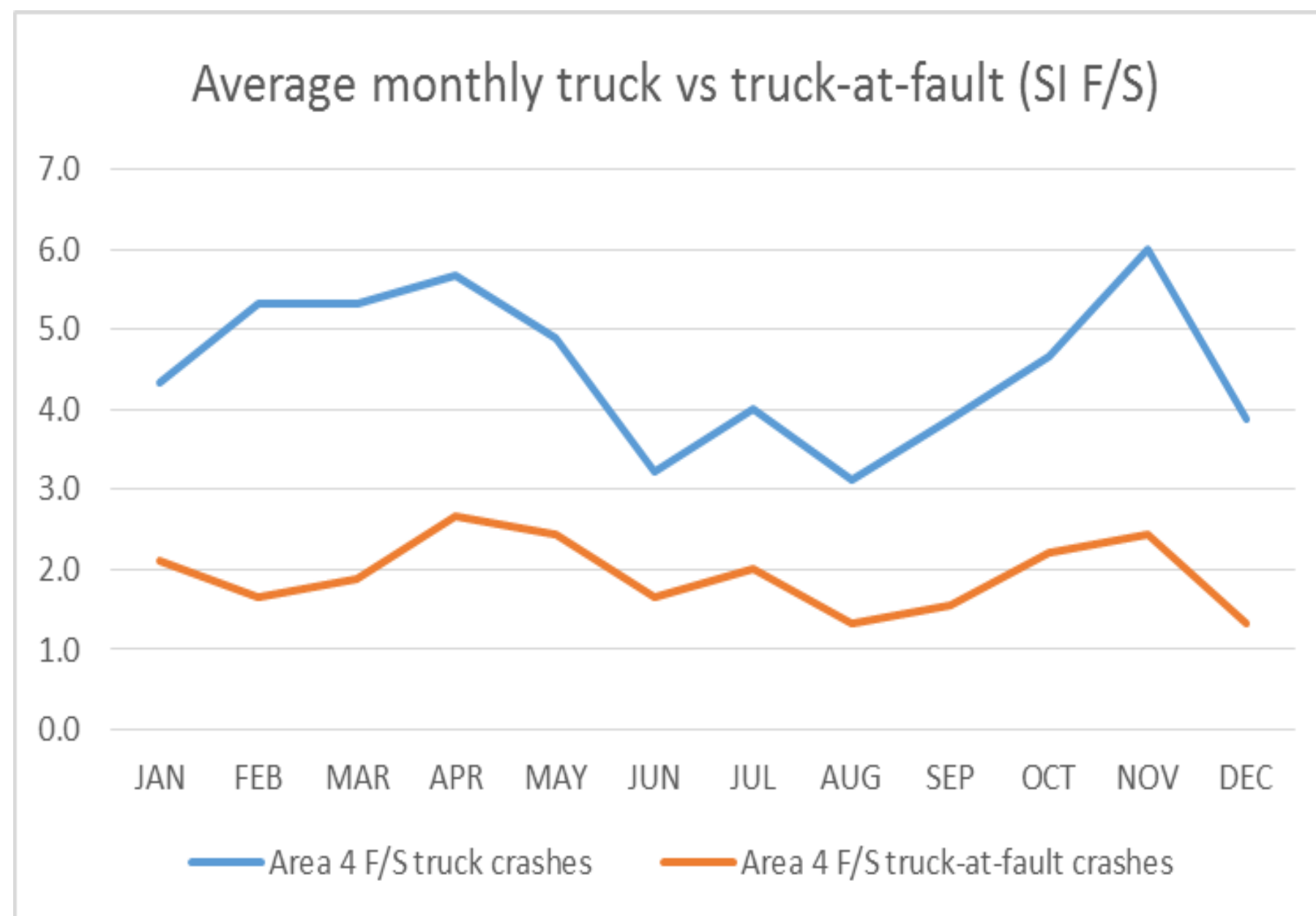

# R – Restraints I – Impairment D – Distractions S – Speed

## DETERRENCE

- Random
- Unpredictable
- Volume

### Dedicated Road Policing:

Deploy to risk:

Speed

Impairment

Times and locations at highest risk

Appears **random** and **unpredictable** but reflects carefully developed deployment to risk times and locations.

### Non-Dedicated:

**Volume** – anytime you spot unsafe driver behaviour (RIDS) make an intervention

Restraints – Impairment – Distraction – Speed

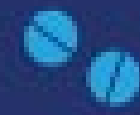

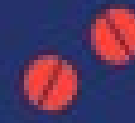

## Impairment legislation samples

2017	Hospitalised	Impaired (CIT failure)
Number analysed	534	418
Potentially impairing drug	311 (58%)	374 (89%)
Cannabis	199 (37%)	231 (55%)
Methamphetamine	138 (26%)	176 (42%)
Opioids	50 (9%)	34 (8%)
Sedatives	61 (11%)	65 (16%)
No drugs	223 (42%)	44 (11%)

### Deceased drivers (2017)

229 analysed

No drugs or alcohol 87 (38%)

Alcohol 66 (29%)

Cannabis 70 (31%)

Methamphetamine 26 (11%)

Other drugs 64 (28%)
