So a big Thank You to **Penske Australia** and **Volvo Australia**.

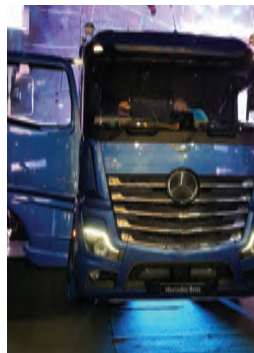


TELETRAC NAVMAN
